



Registering with Stirling Recruitment

To register with Stirling Recruitment you must be a New Zealand resident or have a Right to Work in New Zealand. If you're not a New Zealand resident then the [Department of Immigration's website](#) has details of the types of visas required to work.

Our registration process is thorough but worthwhile, as it means we place quality candidates in quality roles.

You can either apply for a role we have advertised or you can submit your CV via our website or by emailing it to info@stirlingrecruit.co.nz. Once you've submitted your CV, and if you have been assessed as a potentially suitable candidate, you'll be asked to attend our office to register.

The registration process involves completing our forms and to assist with this, you MUST bring:

- valid current photo ID,
- proof of your right to work in NZ,
- your IRD number,
- your bank account details,
- any work-related licences or certificates
- and the contact details for at least two suitable referees

You will be interviewed, evaluated and assessed. All successful candidates seeking temporary work are invited to attend an induction ahead of being placed on assignment.

Once we have completed successful reference checks and you have been inducted, we welcome you to the Stirling Team, and look to place you in the most suitable role!
